Use these questions in your community group time to dig deeper and discover how you can apply today's message to everyday life.

Key passage: John 1:43-51

1. What questions did this week's message raise for you?
2. As you look at the world and the attitude of most people today, what is the spookiest part about inviting someone to church, saying you're a Christian, having a spiritual conversation, etc.?
3. Read today's scripture text, but back up to v. 35 and start with the story of the calling of Andrew and Peter.
 - a) What are the names for Jesus used in vs. 41 & 45 (these are the 3 main titles John uses in his gospel for Jesus)?
 - b) From your understanding, what do each of these names mean about who Jesus is? If you know additional passages that help in understanding these names, share them with your group.
4. Jesus gives Nathanael a pretty high compliment in v. 47, even though Nate had questioned Jesus' pedigree. What do you think Jesus was getting at regarding Nathanael's faith, and the way he lived his life?
 - a) What does Nathanael's response tell you about who he was? Was he certain of anything even though he was rattled by disappointments?
 - b) What, if anything, seems attractive to you about that way of living?

⁴³The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, "Follow me."

⁴⁴Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida.

⁴⁵Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." ⁴⁶"Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" Nathanael asked. "Come and see," said Philip.

⁴⁷When Jesus saw Nathanael approaching, he said of him, "Here truly is an Israelite in whom there is no deceit." ⁴⁸"How do you know me?" Nathanael asked. Jesus answered, "I saw you while you were still under the fig tree before Philip called you."

⁴⁹Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel." ⁵⁰Jesus said, "You believe because I told you I saw you under the fig tree.
