

## Study Questions:

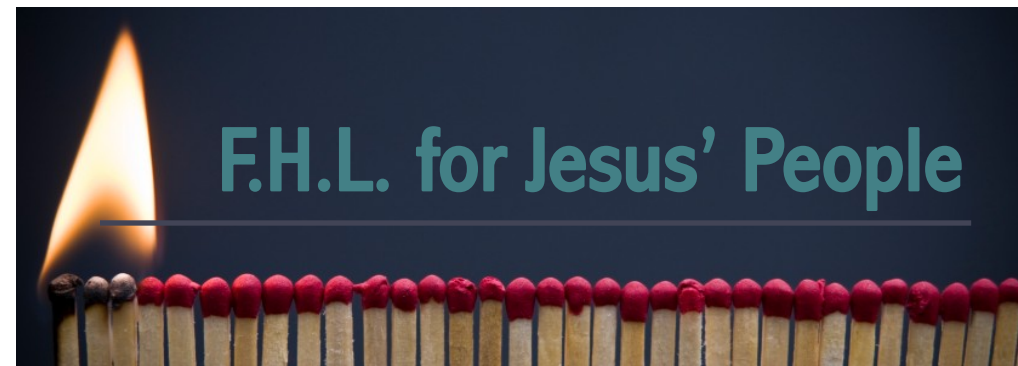
Use these questions in your community group time to dig deeper and discover how you can apply today's message to everyday life.

### Key passage: Hebrews 10:19-25

1. What questions did this week's message raise for you?
2. Read again (out loud if you're willing) John 13:31-38. This is in the upper room just after Judas runs out the door, and just before Jesus goes to Gethsemane. It's also where Peter gets off track and onto the most regrettable mistake of his life. Do you see in this passage where Peter lost his focus and lost his way for that time in his life? [Hint: Check out v. 36—what is Peter still thinking about?]
3. What does Peter's experience show us about what real Christian community can protect us from?
4. Turning to Hebrews 10:19-25...
  - a) Do you see "faith, hope, and love" in this passage? Where?
  - b) How does this text describe for you ways we can help each other with FHL?
  - c) Have you ever had that kind of community? Do you have it now? Describe it for others.
  - d) Are you willing to do the "one anothers" of this text for others? Are you willing to let others do them for you?
5. What practically can you do for someone else in your church family this week to "consider" them, "spur" them, "encourage" them, or "work for" them?
6. Read Hebrews 10:32-39 together. Does that sound like an experience most of us long for in life when it's a struggle? How can your group help each other with "persevering" in FHL?

## F.H.L. for Jesus' People

### Key passage: Hebrews 10:19-25

March 7, 2010

*<sup>19</sup>Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, <sup>20</sup>by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, <sup>21</sup>and since we have a great priest over the house of God, <sup>22</sup>let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.*

*<sup>23</sup>Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. <sup>24</sup>And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, <sup>25</sup>not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.*
