Use these questions in your community group time to dig deeper and discover how you can apply today's message to everyday life.

Key passage: Acts 8:1-8

1. What questions did this week's message raise for you?
2. Read again (out loud if you're willing) Acts 8:1-8.
 - a) Do you see God doing good things in the midst of a very troubling situation? Like what?
 - b) How does this situation fit with what Jesus promised in John 13:35?
3. What do you think of the 3 words that we said describe our vision (i.e. an Attractional Transformational Movement of God)?
 - a) What makes sense about that vision? Any other Scripture verses come to mind that support it?
 - b) What doesn't make sense about that vision?
4. You don't need to talk about amounts or anything like that, but discuss whether you feel led to participate in the Fuel Initiative next weekend. Please end your time with a time of prayer for your church, for all of us as we seek to live God's calling together, and for whatever he wants to do on Palm Sunday and with Fuel.
