Stuff we think you should know . . . about Pulay

■ While the official language of Guatemala is Spanish, the indigenous people of Pulay speak the Mayan language Ixil. Communication with our team often has to be translated twice—from Ixil to Spanish, then to English.

■ Guatemala is recovering from a 36-year civil war which ended in 1996. During that time, Pulay was ravaged and all survivors fled. The families in Pulay today have been living there fewer than 15 years.

■ In order to be eligible for sponsorship through FH, children in Pulay must continue to attend school. Because of this, their schoolrooms are overflowing!
