Many of you have expressed the desire to learn more from the Bible. You've been heard! That is certainly what we're trying to do here at Eastridge. So for the next few weeks we'll take a "Bible Study Principles" approach in our groups.

LUKE 13:22-30

1. Read together Luke 13:22-30 to get the whole picture.
 - What picture of God do you get from this passage?
 - What does Jesus's teaching here tell you about us human beings?
2. Was Jesus answering the question directly, or was he changing it a bit to make a different point? If so, what was that point?
3. Who is Jesus referring to when he gives the house illustration (v. 24-27), and who is he referring to when he gives the banquet illustration (v. 29)?
4. Check out 2 Corinthians 5:10. Does the scene Paul is painting here connect with what Jesus is saying in any way?
5. What does Jesus mean in Luke 13:30? Is that a "fair" thing for God to say?
 - If you've got time, check out the parable in Matthew 20:1-16 where the same phrase is used at the end. What does that say about God's treatment and love for us?
 - Having looked at these parables, what do you think Jesus would say about our uncertain times?
6. Pray together for the people you know who are in danger of a Christ-less eternity. Pray that we as a church family would be praying diligently for people in our town who need Christ and reaching out to them this holiday season.
