 - b. What is our role?
 - c. What do these tell us about God, and how he does and will operate in the world?
 - d. What is the "core" verse in this passage as where the power comes from for sharing the gospel through our lives?
 - e. How about how he wants to work in you and the normal course of your life this week?
3. How does 1 Peter 3:15 shed light on how we can prepare for the "divine appointments" God brings into our lives?
4. Check out 1 Corinthians 9:15-23. What does Paul tell us there about his approach to people who don't know Jesus?
5. On a scale of 1 to 10, "1" being low and "10" being high, where would you put your confidence in the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ?
6. Have you had any "divine appointments" you could share with others as an encouragement? Would you like to pray for more of them?
7. Pray for one another and for our church family that we would let our lights shine all over our and see more divine appointments and the power of Jesus' resurrection all over our Church and community.
